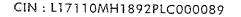

- 1 The above results have been reviewed by the Audit Committee and are approved by the Board of Directors of the Company at their meeting held on February 2, 2021 and have been subjected to limited review by the statutory auditors of the Company.
- 2 The above financial results have been prepared in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (referred to as "Ind AS") as prescribed under section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules as amended from time to time.
- 3 The Company has considered the possible effects that may result from the pandemic relating to COVID-19 on the carrying amounts of investments. COVID-19 pandemic has impacted the Textile Trading business of the company. After making internal assessments, the management does not expect any significant impact on carrying amount of its assets, including property, plant and equipment, Debtors, loans and advances, investment in subsidiaries. The management is confident of continuing as a going concern and meeting its liabilities as and when become due.
- In pursuance of Section 115BAA of the Income Tax Act, 1961 announced by the Government of India through Taxation Laws (Amendment) Ordinance, 2019, the Company has an irrevocable option of shifting to lower tax rate and simultaneously forego certain tax incentives including loss of accumulated MAT credit. The Company has not exercised this option in the current year due to unutilised MAT credit.
- 5 The Company had in earlier year given unsecured loan and business advances to its subsidiary Standard Salt Works Limited (SSWL) amounting to ₹ 5969.82 lakhs (including accrued interest), which was converted into equity shares. The net worth of SSWL post such conversion had become positive and continued to remain as such during the period. Further, in view of the long-term strategic nature of the investment in leasehold rights to salt pans and the growth prospects of the subsidiary which is engaged in the manufacture of salt from the significant leased salt pans that it is holding, no provision for diminution in the value of the investment is considered necessary at this stage.
