However, in view of the long-term strategic nature of the investment and the future growth prospects of SSWL, no provision for diminution in the value of the investment and for the unsecured loans is considered necessary at this stage.

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of Standalone Unaudited Financial Results of Standard Industries Limited (the 'Company') for the Quarter and Nine Months ended December 31, 2015 (the 'Statement'), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015. This Statement which is the responsibility of the Company's Management and approved by the Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Accounting Standard for Interim Financial Reporting (AS 25), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. - 2.
